

Byram Shubert Library Update • July 25, 2008

Many construction elements at the Library recently came to completion. Passersby will take notice of the **ridged metal roof** on the addition, which was designed to complement the metal work in the large windows. With the installation of the air conditioning and heating units, work on all **mechanicals** has been completed. The last set of **exterior concrete stairs** was also finished.

Glass for the windows has arrived. The glass is being installed within the metal frames in stages, beginning with the ground level of the addition. Work will then progress to the original building and the windows of the new conference room, which faces the New Lebanon School. Installation of the carpeting and lighting fixtures in each section will follow as the windows are finished.



The **new Community Room** on the ground level of the addition will feature a **moveable glass partition** that will separate the room from the lounge. The partition provides the meeting area with the flexibility to retain either an open-air atmosphere or privacy for times when the room is in use. The **elevator** has arrived and will take about a month to fully install.

The goal of the construction team has been to open in September, but a delay in the delivery and installation of the windows may affect the opening date by a few weeks.
