

# Byram Shubert Library Update • December 5, 2008

Almost all of the new (and energy efficient) **windows** have been installed in the new wing and the original structure. Some of the new windows are **vent windows**, which can be opened to allow fresh air to circulate. The **exterior glass doors** have also been installed.

All the **interior lights** are in place. **Millwork** has started and is due to be completed shortly. Installation of the **carpeting** will also be finished soon. All of the **furniture** for the library is new and will be brought into the building once the carpeting is done. This will be followed by wiring and installation of the 22 new **computers**. **Heat** is operating



in both buildings allowing **painting** to progress. The **exterior arches** on the original building are being restrained to match the arches on the addition. In addition to the **trees** that were planted in October, the Town recently planted a saucer magnolia and two river birches near the entrance to the library.



*Service continues uninterrupted at the temporary branch. There will be a two-week closing to transport the collections back into the library from storage and the temporary location, to install the computers, and for general preparations for the opening. A notice with the specific dates will be sent out prior to the closing. The goal is to complete construction before the end of the year and to open the library as soon as all final Town permits are received.*
