

Byram Shubert Library Update • October 31, 2008

There is considerable activity at the Byram Shubert Library as the late fall opening approaches. There has been progress on the **windows** with those on the north side facing St. Paul Lutheran Church now installed. It is expected that the windows on the south side of the building looking out towards the New Lebanon School will be completely installed by early November. The **glass doors** for the buildings will be installed about the same time.



Most of the **interior lights**, and all of the **bathroom** and **kitchen tiles** are in place. New **carpeting** has been laid in the original building and will soon be placed in the addition. The **elevator** is in and undergoing testing. Now that the **bookshelves** are being installed and the **boiler** has been connected (allowing for a constant interior temperature), **painting** can begin soon. *Please note that service continues uninterrupted at the temporary branch.*

There has been marked progress outside as well. The **parking lot** and all the **sidewalks** are finished. **Topsoil** has been brought in on the entrance side of the library and raked. The Town delivered and planted several **trees** that were donated in accordance with the landscaping plan. With the trees in place, **sprinklers** and **sod** will be installed along the entrance side. There is still opportunity for contributions to the landscaping plan.
