**The Oral History Project** – Time requirement: 4 hours per month min.

The OHP conducts and preserves interviews with people who have helped to make or witnessed the history of Greenwich since 1890. It has conducted over 1,000 interviews. The project needs volunteers to conduct oral history interviews, proofread and index interview transcripts, help with design and graphics, and publicize the collection.
